**DEPOSIT:** A deposit of \$150 is required at the time of paid reservation. The deposit will only be refunded provided that the leased equipment is returned on time and in the same condition. All stakes and the blower should also be returned! Lessor may take up to 48 hours to fully inspect rented equipment and issue the deposit return.

**ELECTRICAL SERVICE:** Lessee must furnish an electrical outlet with SLO-BLO fuse or 15amp fuse circuit without anything else connected. Use of more than one 50 ft extension cord may cause damage to blower motor. Use only one blower per fuse circuit.

**TERMS OF LEASE:** The Lessee or using party shall be in charge of operation, and is fully responsible for operation after receiving unit. Lessor is not responsible for any injuries occurring to Lessee or to any persons using the leased property. Lessee further agrees to hold Lessor free and harmless against any claims, and further, Lessor shall be indemnified for any and all costs incurred due to claims from anyone; including court & attorney fees; and other related costs involving the use of this equipment. Lessee will provide their own liability insurance unless otherwise specified. Lessee is responsible for the replacement value of the new leased object in the event of theft, vandalism, misuse, fire, or any act which may damage or destroy the leased property.

Failure to observe the terms of this agreement, or failure to make a payment, or failure to have the rented equipment available for return as agreed to, shall make Lessee liable to Lessor for an additional one day rental fee per day until all equipment is returned, plus any court, legal, and/or attorney fees incurred in order to obtain return of these rental products.

**RAIN/CANCELLATION/REFUND POLICY:** The Lessee has the option to cancel up to the time the equipment is released. All cancellations must be made 48 hours prior to scheduled pickup date to receive a 100% refund. Any cancellation made less than 48 hours prior to scheduled pickup date will result in a maximum of a 50% refund. Refund or rain checks will not be issued in the event the leased equipment is not used for any reason. If the equipment does not work properly, it is up to the Lessee to contact the Lessor to correct the issue.

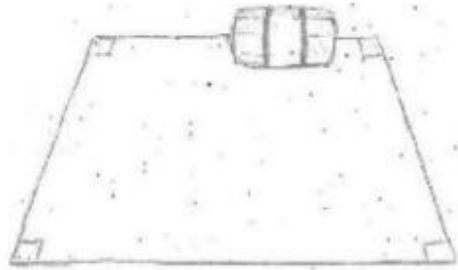
**GENERAL RULES:** Equipment/Unit must be operated over a smooth, level, compatible surface such as grass or hard top surface. The unit may not be operated on rough surfaces such as rocks, bricks, glass, or jagged object. Unit must be anchored prior to use and deflated in high winds or gusts. The unit CANNOT be located within 5 ft of any wall, pole, or fixed object. Children of the same age group must play on the unit at the same time. The maximum number of jumpers in each age group that can jump at one time is listed below. All persons must remove shoes, jewelry, eyewear, and/or other loose articles before entering the unit. An adult must always be present to supervise jumpers. Jumpers are not allowed to play or climb on the outside walls or roof of unit, and may ne jump or play on a partially inflated unit. Never put a hose or water on the unit, in case of rain remove jumpers and unplug motor and extension cord from wall outlet. After the unit has deflated, fold unit in on itself to keep the play area dry. Do not horseplay on unit, no food, drink, or "silly string" is allowed on the unit.

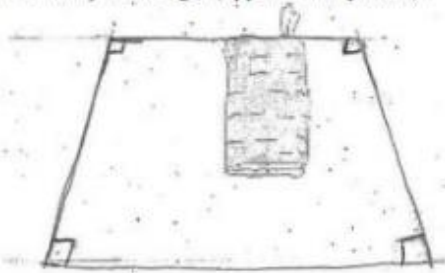

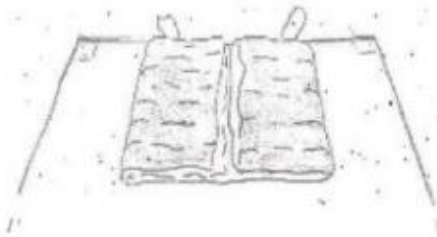

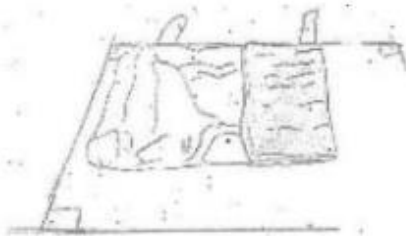
- (1) Lay out tarp and place unit on back side of the tarp (unit unrolls from back to front). P.S. When standing behind the unit, it unfolds twice to the left and once to the right. So make sure the unit is place mostly to the right (opposite this picture).



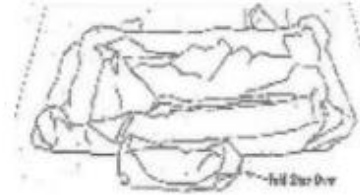
- (2) Remove straps and unroll unit towards the front. Unrolled unit should look like this.



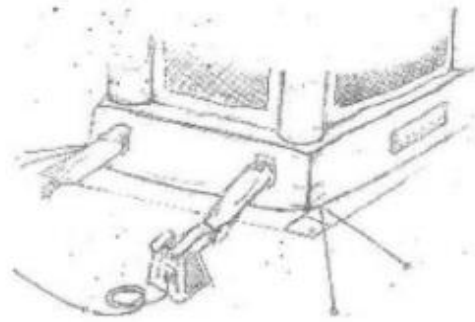
- (3) Start opening the unit and keep centered on tarp.



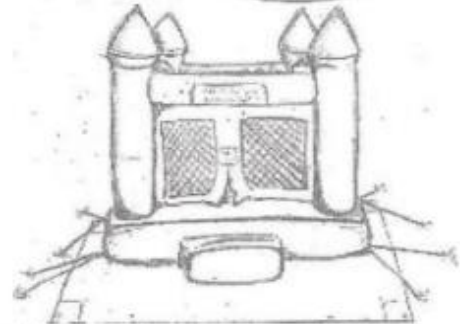
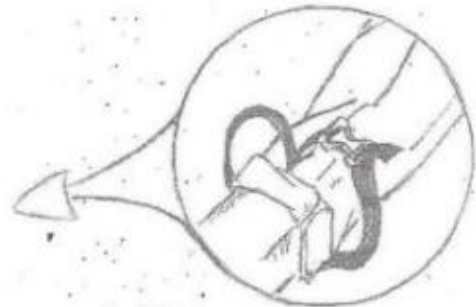
- (4) Open sides and spread out over tarp.



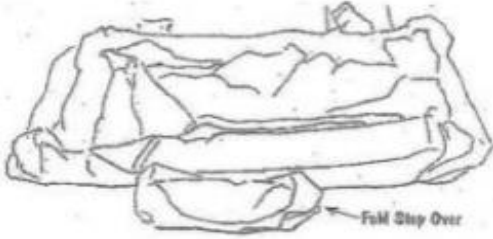
- (5) Lay out the unit where there is room at front of step (unit should be completely on tarp).



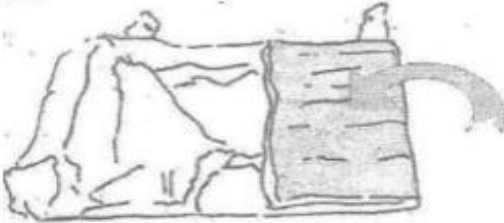
- (6) Attach blower to one tube. Close second tube (fold tube to prevent air from escaping, then strap. Turn blower on. If blower tube flops simply stretch it out.



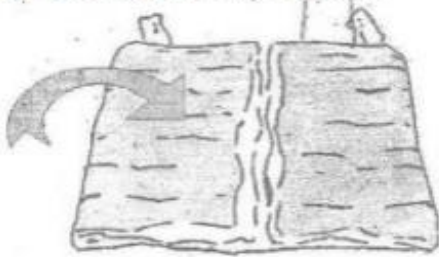
After unit inflates stake down each corner. Drive stakes into ground at an angle away from the unit. Blower runs constantly.



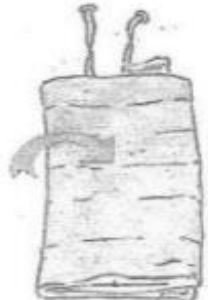
(1) Turn off blower, open the tubes and air pockets (if applicable). Move vinyl around so it is not bunched up in one place.



(2) Fold one side over in half. The seam should go to the middle of the unit. Walk on this side to get air out. No shoes!

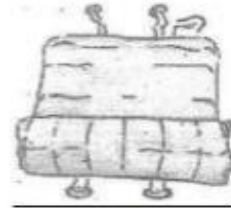


(3) Fold the other side over toward the middle. There should be about a 6" to 8" gap between the two seams. Walk on both sides to get additional air out. No shoes! Air tubes should be stretched out for easy air flow.



(4) Combine both sides. Walk on unit without shoes to flatten before rolling. Place straps under the unit about 1 foot from each side and 3 feet from top (Top is where the tubes are).

(It's best to have someone walk on the unit close to the person rolling it for an easier roll.)



(5) Begin rolling up the unit opposite the tubes. Roll as tightly as possible.



(6) When finished rolling, tuck tubes and extra vinyl under the end of the unit.



7. Strap the roll. Finished roll should look like this.



(8) Stand unit on one end, slide bag over top, then turn unit on the other end to close off bag with the string that's attached to the bag.
